RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. This championship is confined to Registered Connemara Three Year Old Fillies. The progeny of Registered Connemara Sire & Registered Connemara Dam.
2. Exhibitors In both the Qualifier and the Final must have the CPBS Passport ready for inspection prior to entry to the judging ring. **Failure to comply with this rule will lead to immediate disqualification.**

3. A Maximum of **Two exhibits** may qualify, provided the judges feel the standard is high enough for an ISA Championship.
4. One of the Judges at the final must be from CPBS judges list.
5. The Qualifying Exhibitor must fill out their own Qualifying Card at each Qualifying Show. Completed card and entry fee must be handed into the secretary's office on show day.

LOCAL LEAD REIN & LOCAL RIDING PONIES

IPS registered ponies are not eligible to enter any of the classes in the Local lead Rein and Local Riding Pony classes.

Lead Rein Classes - if a competitor takes part in any of the lead rein classes on the day of the show, the only other classes they are permitted to take part in are the Fancy Dress and Lead Rein Performance Hunter class, they are not permitted to compete in any independently ridden class. This rule is linked directly to the rider and it is irrelevant if they are riding a different pony in other classes. We choose to follow these rules to ensure all children get a fair and equal chance of experiencing winning a rosette.

Competitors in these classes not to have participated in any other ridden pony class on the day of the show. The same pony and rider combination are only permitted to compete in one class in this ring on the day of the show, except for the fancy dress and young handler classes. Competitors in the Equitation classes are permitted to compete in the Working Hunter and/or Performance Hunter classes.

IMPORTANT - Rings will not be delayed where there is a clash between horses or riders participating in any other rings on the day of the show. The onus is on the exhibitor to ensure that they have alternative rider/handler available in the event of any clash.

Riders aged over 4 and under 6 years old (not to have attained their 6th birthday). Please ensure you include the child's date of birth as if this class has large entries, the class may further be divided into age groups. The same combination not to have competed in any other lead rein class on the same day except for Best Fancy Dress. Non-IPS registered ponies.

14 LEAD REIN, RIDER UNDER 9 YEARS OLD AND OVER 6 YEARS OLD

Riders aged over 6 and under 9 years old (not to have attained their 9th birthday). Please ensure you include the child's date of birth as if this class has large entries, the class may further be divided into age groups. The same combination not to have competed in any other lead rein class on the same day except for Best Fancy Dress. Non-IPS registered ponies.

15 LOCAL LEAD REIN CHAMPIONSHIP

The individual show to include walk and trot on both reins in a neat figure of eight. Non-IPS registered ponies.

17 EQUITATION, RIDER UNDER 12 YEARS OLD AND OVER 10 YEARS OLD

Rider who has attained their 10th birthday but have not attained their 12th birthday. Please ensure you include the child's date of birth as if this class has large entries, the class may further be divided into age groups. The individual show to include walk, trot and canter on both reins in a neat figure of eight. Non-IPS registered ponies.

18 EQUITATION, RIDER UNDER 16 YEARS OLD AND OVER 12 YEARS OLD

Rider who has attained their 12th birthday but not their 16th birthday. Please ensure you include the child's date of birth as if this class has large entries classes may further be divided into age groups. The individual show to include walk, trot and canter on both reins in a neat figure of eight. Non-IPS registered ponies.

19 LOCAL RIDING PONY CHAMPIONSHIP

20 YOUNG HANDLERS 7-12 YEARS OLD

Handlers must have attained their 7th birthday but not their 12th birthday. Please ensure you include the child's date of birth as if this class has large entries classes may further be divided into age groups. This class will be judged by assessing the handler and the pony as a combination. Handlers **MUST** wear a helmet when leading their pony in this class. Exhibitors will be asked to stand their pony up for the judge, walk and trot in hand as directed.

The class will be judged taking into consideration the following: control of pony, skill in showing in hand - animal in walk, trot and stand for conformation assessment and knowledge of their pony.

Non - IPS registered ponies only.

21 YOUNG HANDLERS 12-17 YEARS OLD

Handlers must have attained their 12th birthday but not their 17th birthday. Please ensure you include the child's date of birth as if this class has large entries classes may further be divided into age groups. This class will be judged by assessing the handler and the pony as a combination. Handlers **MUST** wear a helmet when leading their pony in this class. Exhibitors will be asked to stand their pony up for the judge, walk and trot in hand as directed.

The class will be judged taking into consideration the following: control of pony, skill in showing in hand - animal in walk, trot and stand for conformation assessment and knowledge of their pony.

Non - IPS registered ponies only.

22 BEST FANCY DRESS

Fancy Dress, Local Lead Rein Class. To be ridden by a rider aged 12 years old and under. **Helmets must be worn.** Leader must be over 16 years old. Winner of this Class is not eligible for In-Hand Championship.

WORKING HUNTER PONIES

These are two phase classes where competitors will jump a course of fences and then proceed to complete a ridden show piece to include walk, trot and canter.

The working hunter pony classes will run at the same time as the performance hunter pony classes. There will be two jumping rings in operation on the day.

Children **MUST** be aged 6 year old and over to compete in Working Hunter Classes.
